CHAPTER 1 – STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

The Event shall be known as “2019 CAMS NSW Motor Race Championship Round 1”, to be held on 23-24 May 2019 at Wakefield Park Raceway, Goulburn, NSW. This Event shall be a State Championship Event.

1.2 ORGANISATION AND STATUS

The Event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the NSW Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and Instructions to Competitors that may be issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. 1.5 ENTRIES

Opening Date: on the publication of these Regulations **Closing Date:** Wednesday 20th February 2019

- 1.5.1 **All entries must be completed via the Wakefield Park 'Competitor's portal' on the home page of the website:** (www.wakefieldpark.com.au). You may purchase the Garage/Carport you want at the time of entering the Event. Entries must be received by the closing date above. Any late entries will be at the discretion of the promoter. Please note that no paper entries will be accepted for this race Meeting.

- 1.5.2 If the number of entries received exceeds the maximum number of Competitors as per the Track Density in Article 1.4, the Organiser reserves the right to accept those entries which it deems suitable. Maximum total number of entries will be 315.
- 1.5.3 Entry Fee is \$400 for all categories at this round for entries received prior to 8th Feb 5pm, Entries after this date will be \$450 (both amounts include GST).
- 1.5.4 The Organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries at their sole discretion without assigning reason, in accordance with the NCR 83.
- 1.5.5 The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
- 1.5.5 Provided the Competitor has notified of withdrawal in writing seven days prior to the Meeting, the Entry Fee, less a \$50 administration fee, will be credited.
- 1.5.6 Competitors will not be considered entered until full payment of Entry Fees and Garage Fees (where applicable) are cleared funds.

1.7 PRACTICE/QUALIFYING AND RACING

Practice/Qualifying and race distances will be advised in the Further Regulations.

1.8 PRIZES AND AWARDS

As per Category Series Regulations.

1.9 LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

1.9.1 Competitors in this Event must hold a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit (PCC) Licence (or superior) and be a member of a CAMS Affiliated Car Club. This Event is open to foreign participation. Driver must present their valid CAMS competition licence, CAMS Affiliated Car Club Membership and Vehicle Log Book in person to Sign On in the Admin Office.

1.10 CHANGE OF DRIVER

Change of Driver is permitted at this Event as per the General Competition rules.

1.11 AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilise the automatic Dorian timing system, which requires all cars to be fitted with a Dorian transmitter, which is the Competitor's responsibility. Dorian transmitters are available for purchase from Dorian Industries, Factory 6, 29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing VIC 3029. Phone: 03 9931 1371. OR Hire the Dorian transmitter can be done through Eldee Timing – 0402830313. Bookings are essential as there is limited supply.

1.12 PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

Practice will be available at the Test and Tune day on Friday, 22nd February 2019

The cost of the Test and Tune day is \$150 per Driver (if you pre-enter via the WP online entry system) or \$185 per Driver (on the day). Half-day practice is available for \$95 per Driver for Drivers who sign on after 12:30pm and each Driver must present their valid competition licence in person to Sign On in the Admin Office.

1.13 GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION

- Garages - \$250 (inc. GST) per bay. 66 Available (30 Pit Lane and 36 Paddock Garages).
- Paddock Carports – \$130 (inc. GST) per bay. 60 Available

Garage Allocation will take place at the time of your entry, first come first served basis.

1.14 ADMISSION TO CIRCUIT

Competitors will be issued with 4 Competitor passes per vehicle entered. The Competitor admission passes are the identification required for access to the Marshalling Area and Signalling Areas. There will be no refund for persons having to pay at the gate. Additional passes can be purchased at \$20 (GST inc.) at the gate. Persons not presenting a ticket will be required to pay the normal admission charges.

1.15 SCRUTINY

All vehicles must be in the CAMS Targeted Scrutiny System.

1.16 PROTESTS

Protests shall be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

1.17 POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

1.18 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
